

**Statement from the London Borough of Hammersmith & Fulham and
The Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea Prevent Advisory Group**

29 September 2017

We, the community and faith groups that constitute the London Borough of Hammersmith & Fulham and Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea Prevent Advisory Group (PAG), condemn this terrorist incident that took place on a busy tube train at Parsons Green station, targeting commuters during the Friday morning rush-hour.

This attempt to hurt people going to work, tourists visiting sites of interest and children going to school happened on our doorstep.

We send our thoughts and prayers to the emergency services and those caught up in the incident. As always, our doors are open to all and we will reassure and help our local communities to recover quickly and positively.

This was both an attack against people going about their daily lives and an attack on our values that hoped to scare and divide. This was an act that wanted to challenge our tolerant society. We will not let this happen.

We will never be divided by acts of terror. We are proud to live in London and to be part of the United Kingdom; its values, its people, its courageous emergency services. We will stay united and we will be stronger for it.

So let us not give in to hate and instead help those affected, condemn this senseless and all similar attacks, and work with one another to preserve our society that we all belong to here in London and the United Kingdom.
